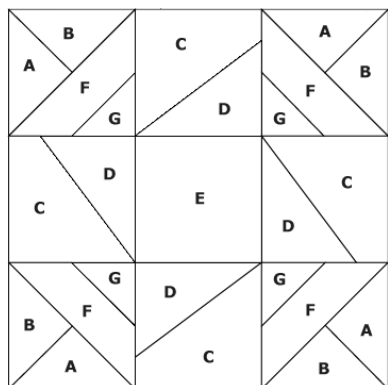


# Round Robin BOM for CottonSpice.com

Utilizing the Sew N'Slash Piecing Style of TK Harrison



Finished Block Size = 10"

Unfinished Block Size = 10 1/2"

### Fabrics Used:

- Stripes (D & E)
- Blue (A)
- Green Neon (C & G)
- Green (B)
- Pink (F)

Seam Allowance 3/8"



### Cutting:

Fabric & Number	Cut
A	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/2" squares, then cut these squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time - you will end up with FOUR (4) triangles
B	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/2" squares, then cut these squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time - you will end up with FOUR (4) triangles
C	Cut ONE (1) 4" x 20" strip
D	Cut ONE (1) 3 1/2" x 18" strip
E	Cut ONE (1) 3 7/8" square
F	Cut ONE (1) 2 3/4" x 12" strip
G	Cut ONE (1) 2 1/2" x 12" strip

### Piecing:

1 Make FOUR (4)

2 Sew the Fabric F strip to the Fabric G strip, pressing toward the Fabric F strip.

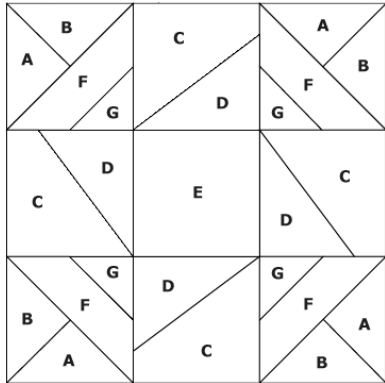
3 Sew the A/B triangles to the Fabric F side of this strip, pressing toward Fabric F. Then, using the A/B triangles as your guide, cut the F/G strip so that you end up with FOUR (4) 3 7/8" squares - this is our Sew N'Slash technique! You will end up with FOUR (4) squares for this part.

Finished Piece

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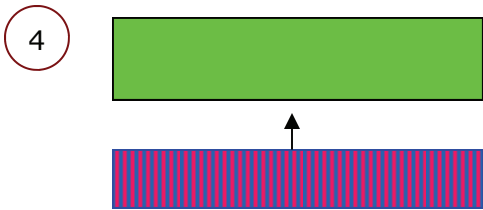
**Fabrics Used:**

- Stripes (D & E)
- Blue (A)
- Green Neon (C & G)
- Green (B)
- Pink (F)

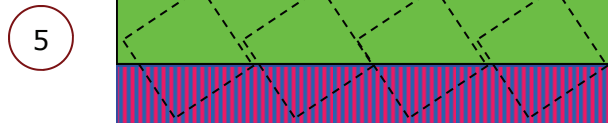
Seam Allowance 3/8"



**Piecing (continued):**



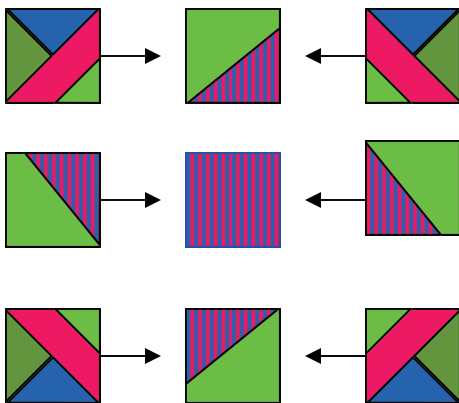
Sew the Fabric C strip to the Fabric D strip, pressing toward the Fabric C strip.



Using your ruler and cutting mat as a guide, again you'll SLASH the fabrics so that you end up with FOUR (4) 3 7/8" squares.



**6 Now, it's time to sew your nine-patch pieces together!**
