All Seams a precise 1/4"

**Read ALL Instructions Before Beginning**

### Fabric & Cutting Requirements for **12"** Mini-Quilt

White	Cut TWO (2) 2 3/4" squares. On the back side of each square, draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White	Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square
White	Cut ONE (1) 6 3/4" square. Then cut this square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
FIVE (5) Scraps	Cut EACH scrap into 2 3/4" squares. For THREE (3) of these squares, cut this square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
SIXTEEN (16) Scraps	Cut EACH scrap into 2 1/2" squares
Heart & Fusible Web	Cut ONE (1) 4" square of EACH

### Fabric & Cutting Requirements for **15"** Mini-Quilt

White	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/4" squares. On the back side of each square, draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
White	Cut ONE (1) 5 1/2" square
White	Cut ONE (1) 8 1/4" square. Then cut this square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
FIVE (5) Scraps	Cut EACH scrap into 3 1/4" squares. For THREE (3) of these squares, cut this square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
SIXTEEN (16) Scraps	Cut EACH scrap into 3" squares
Heart & Fusible Web	Cut ONE (1) 5" square of EACH

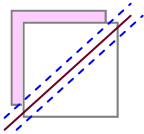


Angel Baby Love - Boy



The instructions are the same whether you make the 12" finished mini-quilt or the 15" finished mini-quilt. These instructions are for the 12" finished size mini-quilt. Just substitute the SIZE of the blocks if you are making the 15" finished mini-quilt.

Place the 2 3/4" WHITE square on the 2 3/4" SCRAPPY square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles. Repeat for the other white and scrappy square. Press the 'like' colored half-square triangles in opposite directions - one toward the white fabric and one toward the scrappy fabric. Once you have sewn and pressed the half-square triangles, take the half-square triangles to the cutting mat and square them up so they are 2 1/2" square - making sure you clip the corners.

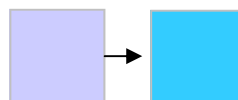

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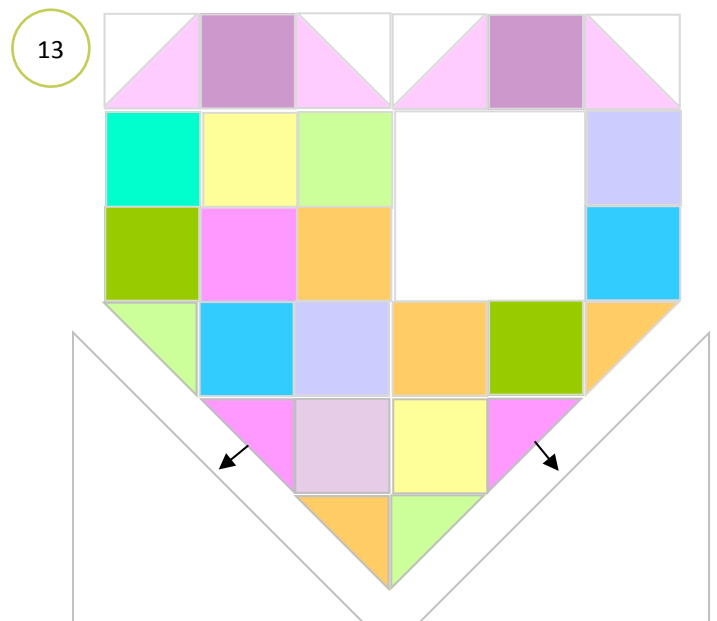
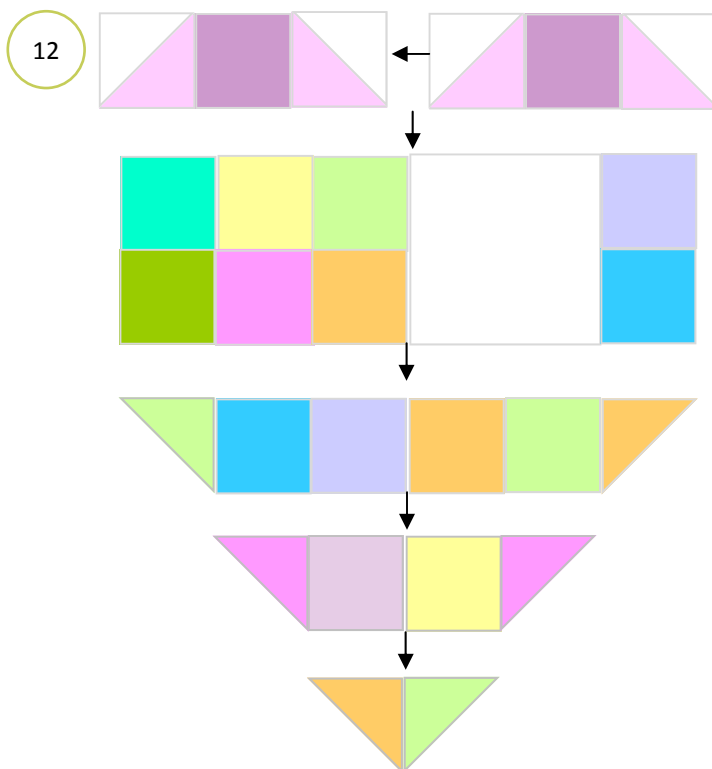
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*The Angel Baby Love mini-quilts utilized an embroidery machine to make the hearts. If you do not have the capabilities to do that, follow these instructions for adding a heart to your mini-quilt. Using the appropriate-sized heart template attached to this pattern, draw a heart on the paper side of your fusible web, then press it to the back side of the SCRAPPY heart fabric. Cut the heart out on the template line you drew. Center the heart on the WHITE 4 1/2" square, remove the paper from the fusible web and press the heart in place. Finally, using a decorative stitch on your sewing machine, secure the heart to the white square, around the edges.*

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*All Teeney Tears mini-quilts have flannel on the backing of a mini-quilt. No batting is necessary. Cut a 12 1/2" square out of flannel. With right sides together, pin the flannel to your Angel Baby Love mini-quilt top. Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew the two together on the right and left sides first, starting from the top of the mini-quilt on both sides. Then sew the top of your Angel Baby Love block to your flannel. You will need about a 6" opening to turn the mini-quilt right sides out so sew the bottom of your Angel Baby Love mini-quilt top to your flannel, remembering to leave an opening. Turn the entire block right side out, using a pointed tool to push the corners of your mini-quilt out. Once the corners are pushed out, lay your mini-quilt on your ironing board and press the two layers together - making sure your edge seams are pushed out and flat. Tuck and press the opening at the bottom of your mini-quilt in and pin the opening closed. Finally, run a top-stitch all the way around the edges of your mini-quilt (no quilting necessary).*
